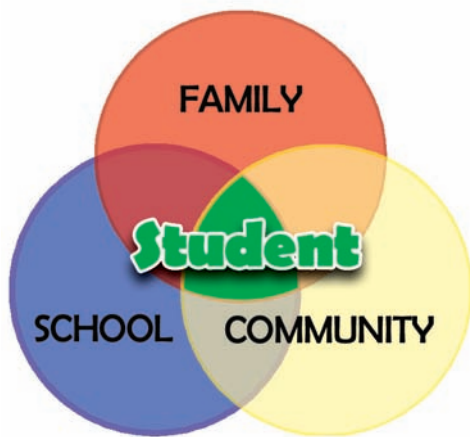

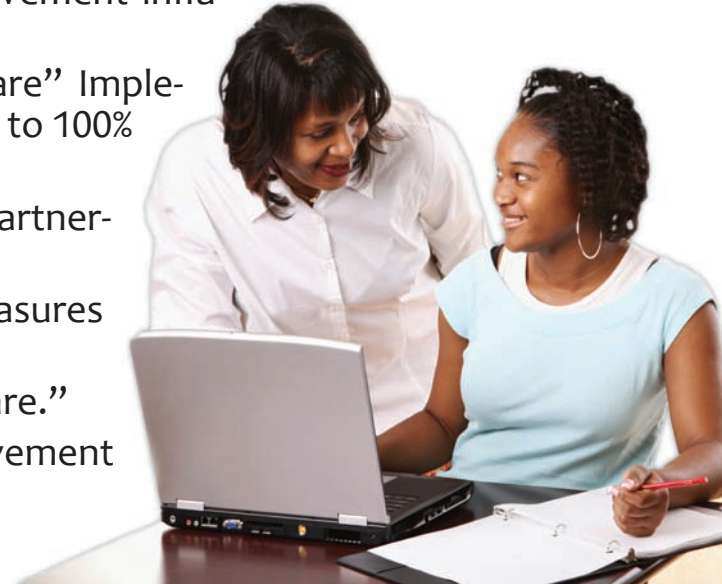


Conference Design
